Delaware County's rich history can be traced amongst the roads and bridges that have connected humans for hundreds of years. Crisscrossing mountainous terrain, river valleys and upland brooks, the 449 bridges of Delaware County tell the tale of perseverance and rugged determination of its inhabitants. While many bridges and footpaths were long ago absorbed into the earth and waters from which they sprung, some of these treasures live to tell their tales. Bridging past and present, the lasting infrastructure of the Western Catskills has an enduring story to tell, so let's go for a ride into the past.

Step Back In Time

The arrival and spread of European settlers in what was to become Delaware County initiated sweeping change. While footpaths, fording or ferrying waterways, and simple stone or log footbridges once sufficed for most of Catskills' human history, animal and machine-powered agricultural industries and the industrial economy expansion after the Revolutionary War required bridges to match the demands of trade and travel⁽⁵⁾. Some of these civil engineering marvels remain and can be enjoyed by driving the countryside one small town at a time.

Bridges, certainly, are more than just a path from one bank to another. Today they are nostalgic reminders of times-gone-by, structures that evoke memories of swimming holes and horseback rides, fishing and family trips, and industries long gone the way of the railroads. As the early twentieth century took hold, wooden bridges in particular were seen not as the architectural, historical masterpieces we know today, but as outdated, unsafe, and obsolete in the face of the newest technological advancements in iron bridge building and the automobile⁽⁵⁾.

While falling out of use in the late 1800s - early 1900s, bridges made of wood also spoke to a modest sensibility that came to light with the replacement of the covered bridge across the Delaware River in Walton's business district in 1887. At the time of the covered bridge's replacement, an iron bridge was proposed which opponents declared would be boastful, showing excessive pride of Walton and its people, and undesirable⁽⁴⁾. In the end, the iron bridge won its place, not only in Walton, but across the country, as covered bridges were left to decay, wash away and be torn down for the iron and steel replacements⁽⁵⁾.

It was not until the early 1930s that covered bridges started to regain their popularity, this time not as efficient structures, but as historical artifacts. The 1940s saw covered bridge tourism rise, and covered bridge societies formed across the nation⁽⁵⁾. Unfortunately by this time, over 80 percent of American covered bridges had been lost. Delaware County was not spared, having lost most of its covered bridges and many other historic bridges to man and nature. Today, our covered bridges are not only surviving, but thriving, and surely they feel the affections of passersby who appreciate the history built into their timbers. Let's get in the car and take a drive to some of the most iconic and historic bridges of Delaware County.

Corbett Roebling Suspension Bridge, 1926

Beginning in Corbett, the area appears as a quiet, forested hamlet running alongside the East Branch of the Delaware River. Connecting state Route 30 to the collection of houses on the other bank, the steel Roebling Suspension Bridge stands as testament to the one-time center of industry.

Located just outside of Downsville, sitting tight against Trout Brook Mountain, the Corbett Bridge was built in 1926 and connected the bustling industrial hamlet of Corbett with main routes to nearby town centers and railroad transportation. An acid factory and sawmill once manufactured nec-

essary products from the abundant forest resources gleaned from the surrounding mountains.

The Corbett Roebling Suspension Bridge was built in 1926 by John A. Roebling's Sons Company, 46 years after the completion of the Brooklyn Bridge built by John A. Roebling. Designed after the iconic Brooklyn Bridge, the Corbett Bridge reflects the innovations of its day. Suspension bridges were new engineering feats of the late 1800s and early 1900s that improved upon past methods and equipment. Wire rope and the cables that were crafted from it were built to last and much stronger than previous hemp or plant fiber ropes. Roebling's products, designs, and ideas were state-of-the-art, and continue to influence bridge and infrastructure construction and design.

A historic treasure, the Corbett Bridge underwent significant rehabilitation in 2006 to address safety and maintenance concerns by the Delaware County Department of Public Works. DelCo DPW maintains 294 county-owned bridges across the county, including the Corbett Roebling Suspension Bridge and the other bridges mentioned in this article. Historical preservation and modern safety precautions live side-by-side in Delaware County's historic bridges.

Today's Corbett Bridge is worth stopping at and admiring. Bring your fishing pole and enjoy the peaceful sounds of nature or snap a few photos of the suspension cables and steel, diagonal support beams. Driving across, enjoy the unique hum of tires on the sturdy, steel grid deck and look down at the river below, remembering that once, not that long ago, horses pulled carts across the bridge deck, loaded with lumber from the hills.

Downsville Covered Bridge, 1854

After saying goodbye to Corbett, get back in the car for a quick drive over to the Downsville Covered Bridge. Spanning the East Branch of the Delaware River, it connects Main Street to River Road. Built in 1854 by Scottish immigrant and Delaware County's most famous bridge builder Robert Murray, the bridge is the oldest covered bridge in Delaware County and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places⁽¹¹⁾.

The bridge's single-span stretches 174 feet across the river and uses both Long and Queensport truss designs. Not only is this construction uncommon in the northeastern

United States, but the Downsville Covered Bridge is the only covered bridge in New York state that uses both truss styles. This engineering feat was Murray's first of several covered bridges in the area, and his workmanship continues to carry vehicles across the river.

The Downsville Covered Bridge was rehabilitated in 1998, requiring a 174 foot laminated beam which was built by Unadilla Laminated Products. The company holds a record for the beam as it is the longest one-piece laminated beam ever constructed. While visiting, be sure to peek underneath the bridge to see this piece of history holding up our past.

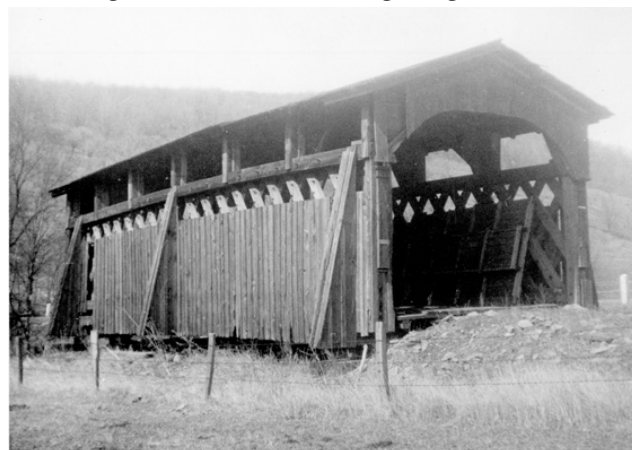
At the time of the bridge's construction, as with the other covered bridges in Delaware County, timber and stone were the most readily accessible materials with which to build bridges. Steel would come later, replacing many wooden bridges that could no longer stand up to the ever-increasing loads and widths of motorized vehicles and Mother Nature's ever-present floods and storms. The Downsville Covered Bridge was engineered by skilled craftsmen who turned the forest into infrastructure, crafting and joining lumber that continues to withstand the test of time.

Be sure to bring binoculars to watch aquatic birds flying from the nearby Pepacton Reservoir, or just sit. Bald eagles are frequently spotted in the valley's skies.

Walton Covered Bridge, Unknown - 1887

Heading out of Downsville, away from the East Branch of the Delaware River along State Highway 206 towards Walton, you'll climb over Bear Spring Mountain and slip down into the village via Bridge Street. Once the site of the Walton Covered Bridge, today a cement slab deck and steel beam superstructure carries travelers over the West Branch of the Delaware River.

Delaware County was once home to over 50 covered bridges, all but six of which have been lost to time. The Walton Covered Bridge was replaced in 1887 by an impressive iron span, then replaced in 1956 by another iron bridge⁽⁴⁾. Driving over today, all three are distant memories, as this route into Walton became heavily traveled, demanding the latest civil engineering achievements. All covered bridges in Delaware County have height and weight limits to protect the integrity of their wooden structures, and even steel bridges, like Corbett Roebling bridge, have limits to

protect them⁽²⁾.

While the new steel bridge was being constructed in 1887, travel was not paused across the river. Instead, a floating pontoon bridge allowed travelers safe passage until it was swept downriver during a flood prior to the steel bridge's completion. Floating pontoon bridges are examples of the ingenuity and resourcefulness of the skilled workmen that labored to create the infrastructure connecting the corners of Delaware County.

Hamden Covered Bridge, 1859

Now it's time to head up state Highway 10 into the heart of Delaware County, arriving at the Hamden Covered Bridge - a quick 15 minutes. While on the way, imagine riding this route horseback, by buggy, or by stagecoach on dirt tracks or sleighing in the snow (or walking it by foot!). Depending on the weather, which might bring rain, sleet, or snow, this trek could take up to a full day of muddy wheels or freezing temperatures. The trips used to take so long, that inns along the way, such as the historic Hamden Inn, provided refuge forgoing to Delhi, back to Walton, and beyond. At one time,

on the trip from Walton to Hamden, travelers would have passed three covered bridges, all of which are gone.

The Hamden Covered Bridge was built in 1859 by the aforementioned Murray, five years after his completion of the Downsville Covered Bridge. That same year, Murray also completed the DeLancey Covered Bridge which burned in 1940 and was replaced by a temporary bridge that lasted through World War II⁽⁴⁾. Murray built each bridge on the East and West Branches of the Delaware River 10 feet longer than the next bridge upstream to allow for the widening of the river, a simple but shrewd tactic⁽¹¹⁾.

The Hamden bridge was constructed for \$1,000 as a single span structure. This is New York's only covered bridge that incorporates a pure long truss design, unassisted by an arch or Queenpost truss, a feature rare

to northeastern covered bridges. In the 1940s a center pier was added for additional support, but the pier was removed in 2000 during a complete rehabilitation that returned the bridge to its original single span.

Rehabilitation and maintenance of historic bridges is critical in ensuring their longevity. Too often, the cost of preserving iconic infrastructure has been deemed too high, resulting in the natural demolition. Withstanding the tests of time, our remaining covered bridges and historic superstructures pull in visitors from across the nation and world to our back roads and small towns.

Kingston Street Bridge, 1940

Which way will you take to Delhi's Kingston Street Bridge when leaving Hamden? Whether you take the scenic forested route and drive along Back River Road to Kingston Street/state Highway 28, or jump back on state Highway 10 to continue up the valley, the Kingston Street Bridge awaits near Delaware Academy.

While the original bridge is long gone, this location was used as a river crossing since way back when. In October 1869 the existing, presumably wooden, bridge was washed downriver after a tremendous flood that took out several others along the same stretch of river. A covered bridge was constructed as a replacement that same fall, however in 1885, 16 years later, it was moved upriver to Fitch's Crossing where it remains as Fitch's Covered Bridge. After the covered bridge was moved, an iron bridge was erected by Groton Iron Bridge Company, with stone work by C. L. Judson⁽⁴⁾. The new iron bridge was one of more than 300 constructed by Groton during a span of less than 10 years⁽⁷⁾.

The Kingston Street Bridge underwent extended rehabilitation in 2015. While one lane remained open during the rehabilitation for travelers, this wasn't the case when the bridge of 1885 was demolished entirely prior to reconstruction from the ground up in 1940⁽³⁾. After reconstruction, the bridge also underwent rehabilitation in 1971. Spanning the West Branch of the Delaware River, today's pony truss bridge extends over 100 feet with two sets of steel polygonal arches rising above the river - which are hard to miss when crossing this impressive superstructure⁽¹⁾.

The light green trusses speak to a history of national bridge building. In 1933, ODOT green, the color of choice for the majority of steel bridges across the United States today, first appeared in Oregon, thus the color's namesake, Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT)⁽⁶⁾. Inspired by the surrounding hills blanketed in evergreens and the desire to create an aesthetically pleasing yet nondisruptive structure, the shade "verde green," later renamed ODOT green, was chosen for a Portland, Oregon bridge. This seemingly simple color choice was mostly unheard of in 1931, but it quickly became the bridge color of choice where until then, black and gray reigned supreme. The green made its way New York, and today blends the Kingston Street Bridge's steel into the surrounding environment just as prescribed, creating a subtle structural beauty that spans space and time.

The Kingston Street Bridge, along with the Hamden and Downsville Covered bridges, and even the site of the old Walton Covered Bridge, offer places of rest for weary travelers. Small public parks are located at each of the four bridges allowing for picnics, bird watching, fishing, and wildlife viewing. At the Kingston Street Bridge, the small park is located just to the south end of the bridge which makes for a great photo op with the structure and river running beneath.

Fitch's Covered Bridge, 1870

Leaving Kingston Street Bridge's steel behind, again there is a travel choice. Heading north on Main Street/state Highway 10 will take you through downtown Delhi and into a valley view, while taking Delaware Avenue runs alongside the river. Whatever road you choose, Fitch's Covered Bridge awaits approximately three miles upriver.

While you drive, imagine the ingenuity it would have

taken in 1885 to disassemble the covered bridge at Kingston Street, piece by piece, and move it three miles across rutted roads drawn by animals to its present location. Moved by David Wright and a town crew, some of the meticulous numbering of each beam and its direction remains. Inside the covered bridge, black paint reveals "Upp" at the top of the wooden cords, as well as the East/West direction. A close inspection may reveal that the directions are backwards, as the crew turned the bridge at its new location⁽⁴⁾. No longer the Kingston Street Covered Bridge, the renamed Fitch's Covered Bridge drew its name from the landowners, Drs. Thomas and Cornelius Fitch, still a familiar area name⁽⁸⁾.

This bridge design is known as a covered lattice through

truss, common for covered bridges of the time⁽¹⁾. The lattice at the top, much like the gaps at the tops of the Downsville and Hamden Covered bridges, allows for air circulation within the structure. This feature, and the cover itself, are critical components in reducing the decay of the wooden bridge decks. Prior to iron, steel, concrete, and pressure-treated wood, non-treated wood and stone were the available materials for bridge building. The roof and sides of covered bridges protect the wood decks from natural decay and weather damage, prolonging the life of the structures that were the height of bridge engineering at the time.

Despite precautions, all bridges must be maintained, rehabilitated or reconstructed. Fitch's Bridge saw its most recent rehabilitation in 2001. While maintaining the bridge's historical integrity, windows were added to the sides, the deck was lengthened, and a new roof and siding were installed. Today, Fitch's, Hamden, and Downsville Covered Bridges are owned and maintained by the Delaware County Department of Public Works.

McLean Bridge, 1900

Now we're off to South Kortright to see the McLean Bridge. Connecting state Highway 10 and county Route 18, this stone bridge crosses the West Branch of the Delaware River, at the far end of the Bovina Center-South Kortright Road. The stone arch bridge was constructed in 1900 by the wealthy and industrious James McLean and the local Mackey family of stonemasons, replacing an iron bridge of unknown age^(3, 9). The skilled stonework is complemented by blacksmith Geo F. Young's wrought iron⁽³⁾.

A brief walk from McLean's historic family estate, the McLean Bridge's stone abutments stand sturdy in the riverbed and banks, the bridge looking much the same today as it did in 1900. The nearly 112-foot long bridge has two spans, with a total deck width of 23 feet⁽¹⁾. Rehabilitated in 1945, the bridge continues to carry traffic across the river. A sturdy bridge was required in this seemingly quiet area to facilitate the travels of guests, powerful men and women, and Eleanor Roosevelt herself, to the McLean Estate, particularly after it was inherited by Alice McLean, James' daughter⁽³⁾. It's possible to imagine that the 1945 bridge rehabilitation was done in anticipation of Alice McLean's inaugural meeting of the International Assembly of Women in 1946, which took place at the McLean estate and spread to the surrounding villages. Hosting 200 women from

over 50 nations for ten days in the fall of 1946 to facilitate world peace, the event surely demanded use of the nearby roads and bridges as the attendees traveled between gatherings and places of stay.

The McLean Bridge is built from local materials dug from the mountains, and as any Delaware County farmer can attest to, there is never a shortage of stone. Stone bridges, much like wooden covered bridges, tend to be things of the past, having been replaced by long-lasting steel. It is of note that McLean, who made his fortune in copper, mined materials, and railroads, chose stone, and not metal, to not only build his bridge, but to replace the once-standing iron bridge⁽¹⁰⁾. While visiting, be sure to rest your hand on the stones which were laid, one-by-one, over a century ago by the vanishing art of Delaware County stonemasons.

The McLean Bridge is not the end of the bridge trail. There are plenty of bridges hidden amongst the Delaware County terrain. If you're feeling especially adventurous, throw a kayak in the river at Kortright and paddle your way back to Walton, near the start of our journey. Floating beneath the bridges will give you an unparalleled view of the beams holding the bridges aloft, from bank to bank, abutment to abutment.

It's important to remember that historical bridges require special care. Heed signage regarding weight, height, and width limits to help ensure the continued use of these centennial structures into the future.

In this land of headwaters, rivers, kills, creeks, streams, brooks, and waterfalls, bridges take us from past to present, history to future. Enjoy the ride.

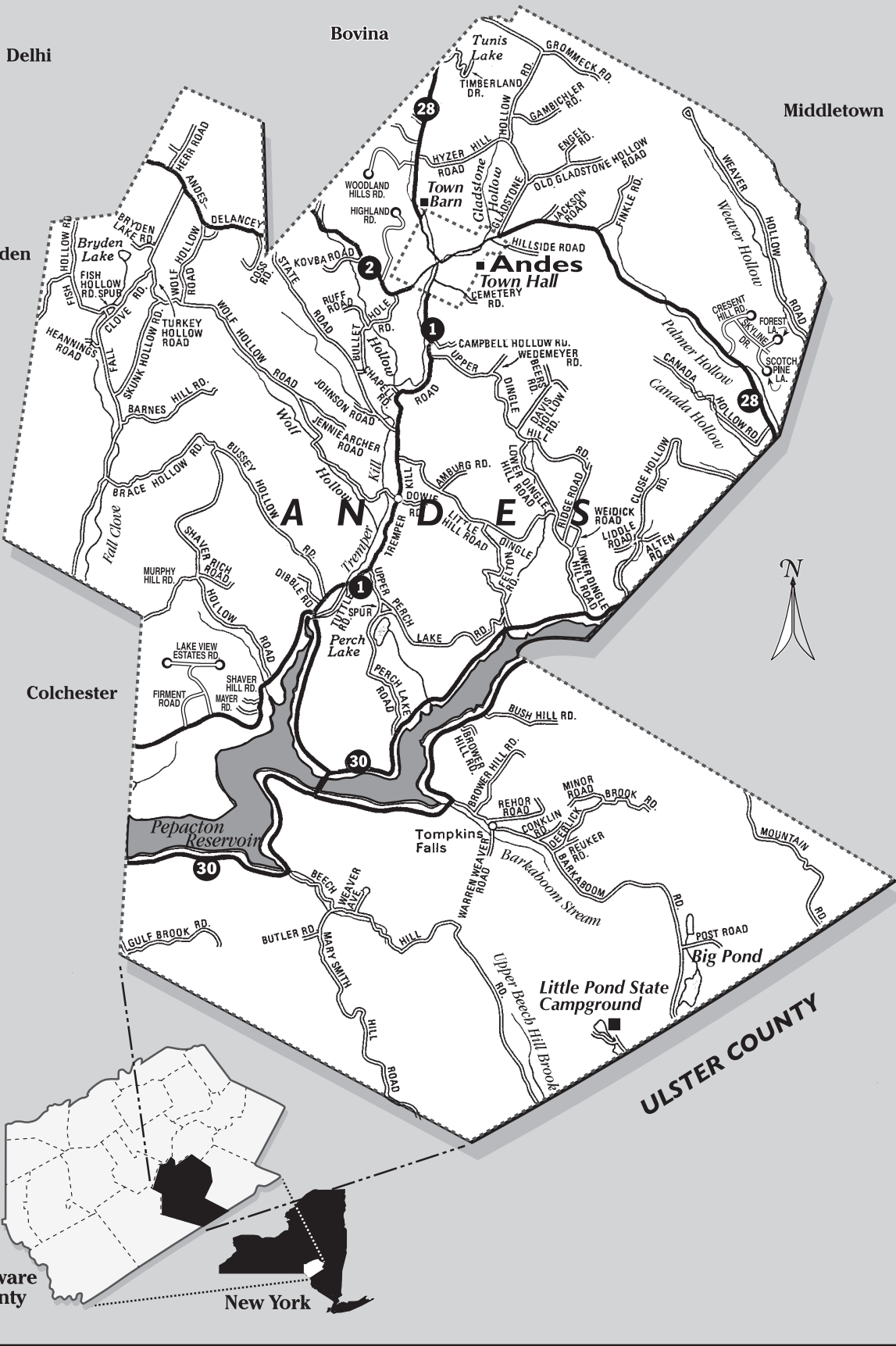
